S2. Although the next federal election is not for a while, how likely is it that you will vote in the November, 2008 elections for President, and other federal, state and local offices? Would you say **ROTATE TOP TO BOTTOM; BOTTOM TO TOP**

- 1. Very likely ..... 95%
- 2. Somewhat likely ..... 5%
- 3. Not very likely ..... **TERMINATE**
- 4. Not at all likely ..... **TERMINATE**
- 5. DK/Refused ..... **TERMINATE**

And thinking now about healthcare...

F1. If a candidate for the Presidency proposed a national healthcare plan with universal coverage of abortion at taxpayer expense, would you be **ROTATE** more or less likely **END ROTATION** to vote for that candidate?

**IF MORE LIKELY/LESS LIKELY, ASK:**

And, would you say you would be MUCH (more likely/less likely) or SOMEWHAT (more likely/less likely)?

**Total Less likely..... 56%**
